

Join us for an evening of fun for the benefit of The Genesee Valley Conservancy

At Quiz Night, teams (of friends, family, co-workers, others) seek to out-score other teams on questions in roughly 10 diverse categories together with a picture quiz (more on this later). The questions are devised by an experienced group of Quiz Masters. The sought-after trophy in this contest of wits, knowledge and guesswork is a glamorous cup of possible historic significance – well, at least 10 years old.

Here's how the Quiz works

Teams shall consist of no more than 8 people. The Quiz starts promptly at 7:00 p.m. The Quiz Masters will read each question twice (not once and not three times!). At the end of each round teams swap papers with an adjacent table and the Quiz Masters give the answers. (This is not a democracy and their decision is final. Arguments about the correct answer will be conducted at the bar in the Tavern at the end of the quiz). Each team marks the sheet of the adjoining team then hands it back. Volunteers circulate to pick up the sheets to take up to the scorers. There will be a scoreboard which is updated as the Quiz progresses.

The Picture Quiz is available as early as 6:30 pm. Teams have all evening to work on identifying the images in the Picture Quiz, which comprises about a third of the team's total score.

Organizing a team

Each team must have a team name and a team captain. Team Captains: organize your team and mail in the attached registration form with payment as soon as possible, or register online. "Spectators" are not allowed at the team tables. For team members registering separately, you must show the team captain's name on your form. On Quiz Night, team captains **must** check in at the Registration Table to hand over the final **team form** along with payment for any additional team members. Blank team forms will **NOT** be available on the night. The Quiz Masters will then release the Picture Quiz to the team. Individuals who do not have a team are very welcome to register and will be assigned a team.

One final piece of advice: diversity breeds success. Teams with a mixture of ages and interests will have a greater chance of answering all the questions.

The use of mobile devices (cell phones, tablets, etc.) is strictly prohibited.

Food and beverage

The Big Tree Inn will have a special dinner menu for Quiz Night from 4:30 pm until Quiz time, and again after 9:00 pm. Reservations are strongly advised. There will be a well-stocked cash bar available during the Quiz.
